The last 8 years of my 30+ career, I was a Captain/Paramedic. I continue serving in the fire service by working for WA DNR in the summer as part of an Incident Management Team. I am the Incident Safety Officer for North East Washington Interagency Incident Management Team #3. I worked in that capacity on both the Gray and Oregon Road fires in Spokane County during the summer of 2023. I also teach wildland firefigthing at Spokane Community College's Fire Science Program. I also started volunteering last winter for Spokane Fire District 4 as a Water Tender driver/instructor.

I firmly believe my 30+ years of trusted front-line experience as a firefighter/officer/paramedic will bring a unique and invaluable perspective to Fire District 4's Board of Commissioners.
