# The Immigration Debacle

"In FY 2018, the [Yuma] sector [of the Border Patrol] incurred more than \$700,000 in medical care costs to cover 1,700 aliens who were apprehended and who had to be transported to the hospital..."

Yuma saw 8,800 apprehensions in 2020. We have also seen a rise in mumps, influenza and tuberculosis.

Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) used Title 42 to swiftly expel immigrants at the border. A 1944 Public Health Service Act, President Trump reinstated it to protect Americans from the Covid-19 pandemic. With few exceptions, Democrat leaders support lifting Title 42, salivating over the possible [illegal] voting pool. What a quandary. \* Terrorism - Over 40 Jihads crossed our border in the last 12 months. How many have eluded detection and are now plotting against a country they hate? Mayorkas "has it all under control" though, deploying "600 law enforcement officers to the border... referring smugglers and 'certain' border crossers for criminal prosecution." And he has assured us that applicants are being removed if they fail to provide valid asylum requests. Hmm.

\* Drugs - "CBP officers, Border Patrol agents, and Air and Marine Operations agents continue to interdict the flow of illicit narcotics across the border. Nationwide, drug seizures (Cocaine, Methamphetamine, Heroin, Fentanyl, and Marijuana) by weight were up 37 percent in April compared to March. Seizures were as follows":

- Cocaine seizures increased 96 percent
- ➤ Methamphetamine increased 20 percent
- Heroin seizures increased 138 percent
- Fentanyl seizures increased 23 percent

Seizures of fentanyl coming into the USA: 2800 lbs. in 2019; 4800 lbs. in 2020 and 11,200 lbs. in 2021. Recent reports are that it's being mixed with cocaine. In simple terms; Fentanyl is produced in China, transported to Mexico, and smuggled past our now very porous American borders. Yeah – there's a problem.

SPOKANE CITY NEWS: Water Restriction and Fining Ordinance C36209.

Spokane City Council passed the ordinance and Mayor Nadine Woodward <u>VETOED</u> it. Unfortunately, it was overridden by the five Democrats on the Council.

Make note: Council Members Jonathan Bingle and Michael. Cathcart were the lone dissenters to the vote. The Council failed to provide adequate information on what the restrictions and fines would be, expecting members to vote blindly. In their postpublic comments, the two "no's" pointed to great issues with the ordinance details.

"Why no Council input or explanation at the beginning before the folks presented?"

Approximately 32 citizens commented via phone or in person. The consensus in favor/opposition was about 50/50. The Spokane "River Keepers" overwhelmed the process, pushing for the restrictions, fines and government oversight on water usage. But many testified that massive government overreach had no place in an area that NO WATER EMERGENCY nor WATER SHORTAGE existed. Therefore, no restrictions were needed.
