Who is Teaching Our Children?

My alma mater; Joel E. Ferris High School. I was 16 and thought my history teacher was a "misogynist" for giving me a bad grade on a paper. Well in reality, I didn't put in the effort and actually deserved the grade I got. Now as a parent, that experience pales in comparison to the educational tyranny we are dissenting to today. Moreover, our children are getting caught in the crossfire. One parent shares an experience of the 2019-20 virtual school year:

"During [virtual] class, my child's Advanced Placement U.S. History teacher assigned a reading based on Walter Williams Lee's 'Two-Spirit People of Indigenous North America'. The gender undertones of the subject matter and fact that Mr. Lee was a pedophile featured on the FBI Most Wanted in 2013, compelled me to ask what relevancy to history it had. The teacher responded by saying it was a [personal] moral obligation to refrain from teaching 'whitewashed' history out of the textbooks. Moreover, my child would have to study for the AP U.S. History exam without help from the teacher. Piqued, I began to covertly monitor my child's classes. I witnessed students being instructed to read an article by Ibram X. Kendi; a self- proclaimed antiracist who writes about how Americans are racist. More bothersome was the proud display of BLM signage in camera view. My child objected to the propaganda and was quickly rebuked in front of peers. The teacher seemed to have directed the terms 'Racist' and 'White privilege' toward my child".

School Districts and Board Members work for us; We do not work for them. There are teachers and administrators who oppose the current propaganda but are in fear of losing their jobs.
