## Team Builder and Team Member Synergy is Critical



### Characteristics of Winning Teams - Synergy and Mission Focus

A political party organization, whether focused on advocacy or policy, relies heavily on coordinated teamwork to function efficiently and effectively. Success is shaped by the combined roles of the team builder—such as an organizational leader (Chair) or Board of Directors who sets priorities based on the organization's Vision and Mission—and the team members (Leaders, PCOs, and Volunteers) who carry out strategic and operational responsibilities to support the priorities set by leadership.

The team builder in a political organization plays a critical role in shaping direction and coherence. This role involves articulating a clear vision, mission, aligning members around shared values, and establishing structures that support collaboration.

Research on effective teams emphasizes that strong leadership fosters trust, open communication, and accountability, all of which are essential in politically sensitive environments where differing viewpoints must be managed constructively.

Team builders are also responsible for resolving conflicts, coordinating efforts across roles, and ensuring that the organization adapts to changing political contexts. Studies on team dynamics show that leaders who focus on enabling collaboration rather than exerting control contribute to higher performing teams.

Team members, in turn, are responsible for transforming organizational priorities into concrete outcomes. Their role includes active participation in discussions, responsible execution of assigned tasks, and respectful engagement with differing perspectives.

Successful team members contribute their expertise while remaining aligned with priorities, which is particularly important in political organizations that often face external scrutiny and time pressures. Examples from real-world teamwork research highlight that mutual support, clear communication, and role flexibility strengthen overall effectiveness.

Ultimately, a successful political organization depends on balance. The team builder provides vision, stability, and encouragement while team members contribute commitment, competence, and collaboration.

When both roles function in harmony, the organization is better equipped to pursue its objectives ethically, respond to challenges, and sustain long-term effectiveness within a complex and often evolving political environment.
