

PCO PROXY FORM

The Bylaws of the Spokane County Republican Central Committee state the following:

FROM SCRCC BYLAWS

"4.4.5: Any PCO who is unable to attend a Central Committee meeting may issue a written proxy notice authorizing another Republican residing within that PCO's precinct to vote in place of that PCO at that meeting. Such proxy notice shall include the Proxy's name and residential address and shall be delivered to the Credentials Committee at least 24 hours prior to the meeting. No person may have more than one vote. If a PCO is unable due to unforeseen circumstances to give proxy notification at least 24 hours prior to the meeting, the proxy may be admitted pending Creditals Committee certification and a simple majority of vote of the Central Committee."
